


% Overweight & Obesity in Adults in Slovenia based on SELF REPORT height & weight (2006-9)




















Changes in prevalence of Overweight (%) in 15 year old girls between 2001 & 2013/14



% Overweight & Obesity in Slovenian Female Adults by Income Quintile in 2008 & 2014




% Overweight & Obesity in Slovenian Male adults by Educational attainment 2008 & 2017


% Overweight & Obesity in Slovenian Female adults by Educational attainment 2008 & 2017














Diabetes age-adjusted comparative prevalence [%] in adults living in EU Member Countries (2017)


Colorectal Cancer incidence in males living in EU Member Countries






Pancreatic Cancer incidence in females living in EU Member Countries

Cancer of the Oesophagus incidence in males living in EU Member Countries


